

The Trust maintains its transparency through an annual Chartered Accountants M/S GRANT THORTON ANJUM RAHMAN.

The Trust deed was executed by Syed Raza Kazim, the Patron of SNPET. He is a visionary, an internationally acclaimed lawyer, musicologist, photographer, philosopher, inventor of sound systems, and the Shruti Venna, a renaissance man. ## History of Sanjan Nagar Public Education Trust Higher Secondary School (SNPET-HSS)

In 1995, the Sanjan Nagar Public Education Trust (SNPET) was set up as an English Medium high school for girls in the Kot Lakhpat industrial area of Lahore. The flagship school was upgraded to Sanjan Nagar Public Education Trust Higher Secondary School (SNPET-HSS). SNPET-HSS is registered with the School Education Directorate, Lahore Govt of Punjab. In August 2003, the school shifted to its purpose-built facility in Glaxo Town, Ferozepur Road, Lahore.

From a free of cost facility, in 2011 September, the Board reviewed the program's sustainability and introduced a fee at one-fourth of the cost in September 2011. SNPET is committed to families in need and provides scholarships/subsidies for 10 -12% of students from its funds.

## CURRICULUM STRATEGIES

At Sanjan Nagar Public Education Trust Higher Secondary School the pre-primary and primary sections follow the International Baccalaureate (IBO) Primary Years program IB-PYP which focuses on the following approaches:

- **Inquiry-Based**
- **Learner-Centered**
- **Outcomes Focused**

The school was authorized for International Baccalaureate PYP (Primary Years Program) in 2014. It is the first IB-PYP (International Baccalaureate Primary Years Program) authorized School in Pakistan for the disadvantaged, with 110 scholarships.

# THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB-PYP)

The SNPET-HSS is aligned with “The International Baccalaureate” curriculum for the primary years program (Preschool to Grade 5). The IB-PYP aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable, and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

To inculcate this spirit, the school works with a range of partner schools, parents, governments, and international organizations to develop challenging international education programs and rigorous comprehensible assessments.

These programs encourage students worldwide to become active, compassionate, and lifelong learners who appreciate and respect human diversity.

The IB Primary Years Program (PYP) is a comprehensive curriculum Framework for preschool through grade fifth, focusing on the development of the whole child. It is a unique international program of guidelines that encompass social, physical, emotional, and cultural needs in addition to academics. High standards are set, and there are high expectations for the students.

The methodology of this program uses inquiry strategies to gain more knowledge and create depth in learning about particular topics. In a nutshell, a great deal of time is spent by students and teachers working toward answering a few broad questions using many resources and a combination of subject areas.

The PYP units of inquiry are designed around six Trans-disciplinary themes ( Who we are, Where we are in place and time, How we express ourselves, How the world works, How we organize ourselves, and sharing the planet) along with PYP five essential elements (Knowledge, concepts, skills, attitudes, and action) which have significance for all students, in all cultures; and offers students the opportunity to explore and to inculcate international mindedness which is of genuine importance in understanding the human condition.

# FACILITIES AT SNPET-HSS

SNSS strives to provide its students and teachers with state-of-the-art facilities for well-rounded learning experiences. The facilities include:

## **Custom Built School**

In August 2003, the school shifted to its purpose-built facility at Glaxo Town, Main Ferozepur Road, covering 13 canals or 6500 sqft. Yards. In April 2004, the Federal Minister for Education, Zubaida Jalal & the Provincial Minister for Education, Mian Imran Masood, performed the formal inauguration of the school building.

## **Dedicated Staff**

SNPET-HSS strives to recruit capable and committed faculty members to teach 21<sup>st</sup>-century skills. SNPET-HSS seeks to upgrade the quality of its human resources through regular training by renowned trainers, training, and research institutions. We believe the ordinary can be made into extraordinary professionals.

## **Libraries**

The school has two libraries for primary and senior school separately. Each is well equipped with almost 10,000 books, providing reading and reference material for students and teachers with access to online resources. Six trans-disciplinary themes are organized for the primary years in the library and progressively relevant books for middle and high schools. The library also supports A/V resources, including television and multimedia.

## **Computer Labs**

Computer labs and integrated IT facilities in classrooms are in place to ensure that ALL students become fully enabled IT users, from a very young age. The latest ICT techniques include project-based learning and teacher training with in-house presentations and group learning. IT-based lesson preparation, research, and assessments are compulsory for all faculty.

## **SNPET- NBP “Tech-Enabled Resource Center”**

Recently a separate High-Tech Lab is built in the high section to train especially girls in digital livelihood skill. Studentns of SNPET-HSS Alumni and community would be empowered by short/long term ICT in demand professional courses and development training programs.

## **Science Laboratories**

Three fully equipped science laboratories are aligned to the science curriculum so that experiential learning for physics, biology, and chemistry is systematically in place.

## **Art Room**

Art is an integral and vibrant part of the SNSS curriculum, focusing on creative expression, and is aesthetically integrated across all subjects. Students are encouraged to work with diverse media: watercolor, oil, charcoal, crayons, markers, pencil work, and clay for vibrant displays.

## **Play /Sports Areas**

Sanjan Nagar has a spacious playground for all sports activities. Some favorite sports are karate, cricket, aerobics, and individual and group sports.

## **Music**

Music is a source of emotional energy at the Sanjan Nagar HSS. The school has renowned faculty in Classical South Asian music. Besides formal music classes for all grades, students have a music club providing an opportunity for musical expression. The Sanjan Nagar school choir is sought after for its excellence.

## **Custom built Auditorium**

Performing arts is integral to the SNPET-HSS curriculum. Sanjan Nagar has an auditorium for 500 audiences. This is a multi-purpose space for formal assemblies: lectures, award ceremonies, theatre, and music productions.

The School Auditorium was formally inaugurated by Ms. Joanna Roper, UK Envoy for Gender Equality, on August 30th, 2018. Ms. Roper is an ambassador for promoting girls' education and gender empowerment.

## **First-aid Room**

Sanjan Nagar is affiliated with The Children's Hospital & the Institute of Child Health for periodic doctors' visits for free medical checkups and emergency and tertiary medical services at the hospital. A Health Fund operates to provide emergency relief to students and their families. *There is a dedicated room on the campus for first-aid facilities supervised by a health worker.*

## **Collaboration for inclusion & Learning Disabilities**

The school collaborates with AMIN MAKTAB to promote Inclusive Education and support children with disabilities. Individualized Education Profiles (IEPs) help children with mild to moderate problems adjust to mainstream schools.



# LIFE AT SNPET-HSS

## Student's Learning and Skills Development PYP Exhibition

Sanjan Nagar Primary years(Grade 5) organizes a PYP exhibition every year to represent the learning experiences of PYP learners, synthesizing the essential elements of knowledge, concepts, attitudes, skills, and activities of the PYP and sharing them with the whole community.

As a culminating experience, it is an opportunity for students to exhibit attributes of the international baccalaureate learner profile they have been developing throughout their engagement with the PYP.

## Pen Pal Activity

In 2017, IB-PYP year five collaborated with Notre Dame Marist Academy for Pen Pal. SNPET learners were paired with a Pen Pal in a Pontiac U.S. state of Michigan school. Learners are contacted via e-mail to learn new things and a new culture. "Pen-pal was an excellent opportunity for learners to make new friends and learn about a different culture. They shared local issues and their impacts on their societies.

## Open House Day- An Annual Expose on Open Learning

Open House Day is one of the popularizing learning methods practiced at the SNPET-HSS campus for parents and learning communities to see students engaging in experiential learning. Students conduct the Open House to share their project-based work in each grade in a trans-disciplinary manner, creatively and confidently. It is a display of 'SNSS' spirit and essence. As the key event in the academic calendar of SNSS, the Open House Day has become an annual landmark for displaying learning and life skills as students confidently usher visitors to classrooms exposing them to new pedagogies that work!

## Field Visits:

SNPET actively promotes field visits as part of the experiential learning of students and faculty. These have included: Taxila, Harrapa, Khewra Salt Mine, Murree Hills, Science Museum, local Farms, Factories, Hotels, and Race Course Park.

## Opportunities for Students to study Abroad-iEARN

Since 2006, each year, students from Sanjan Nagar are selected on merit to visit the U.S.A annually for a year-long program through the (International Education and Resource Network) iEARN. YES, or Youth Exchanges and Study, is a program for secondary school students to spend one Academic year in the U.S.A. Students live with host families, attend high school, and engage in community life.

iEARN is currently responsible for the recruitment of students from Pakistan. iEARN is partnering with several other organizations, including AYUSA, AMIDEAST, Close Up Foundation, and Sister Cities International, to enhance the program through ongoing online project partnerships among participating schools. As part of the program, participating students exchange experiences via iEARN cyber-diaries. YES, alumni stay connected and share the ongoing impact of their year in the YES Consortium Alumni Database.

Several students have received this fantastic encounter in the USA; homes, schools, and society.

To date, 13 students from Sanjan Nagar have participated in the YES Alumni group.

### Amin Maktab

Collaboration for inclusion & Learning Disabilities with Amin Maktab The SNPET-HSS continues to work in partnership with AMIN MAKTAB to promote Inclusive Education and support children with learning disabilities. Ms. Sadia Yousaf, a psychologist, visits SN twice a month, conducting sessions with students, teachers, and parents to address mental health issues. Bridging Barriers-LUMS Community Project Bridging Barriers is a project of the LUMS Community Service Society that educates children from struggling socioeconomic backgrounds. In addition to providing education through their syllabus, designed to help groom and develop the

children, different sessions and events are also arranged to educate and allow students to display their skills and knowledge. Students are prepared to participate in Olympic competitions through 16 sessions, 14 held annually, on; Public speaking, World history, General knowledge, Social and Regional issues, Personal Well-being, and Local History.

### Annual Girl Guides Camp at Murree

Girls' Guide Camp provides a safe place for young people to try new things and challenge themselves to become active citizens of Pakistan. Girls Guide camp helps our girls to explore leadership skills, develop an appreciation for nature, learn life skills and make unforgettable memories. The school organizes to arrange annual Girls' Guide Camp in Murree every year in the month of June.

- Annual Faiz Festival
- Faiz Festival is a regular annual event where literary, poetic, and cultural events are organized to mark the birthday of a celebrated poet, Faiz Ahmad Faiz.SNPET students participate on an annual basis to pay their tribute to the legendary poet Faiz Ahmad through following.
- AFS Intercultural Program

- Ed-Tech Learning
- Ed-tech is an integral part of SNPET's teaching and learning process. To meet the digital era's needs, SNPET provides a modern digital platform for its students.

# CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR TEACHERS at SNPET-HSS

## Professional Development Programs for Faculty

SNPET believes in investing robustly in the quality of its human resources. Sanjan Nagar School System (SNSS) teachers engage in continuous professional development on and off campus throughout the year. All faculty members, including old and newly appointed teachers, have equal opportunity for professional training aligned to the needs of their subject. The Education Committee, with all its committed members' inputs, ensures high-quality faculty training. Some of the training are listed below:

## BO-PYP In-school Workshops

Making Primary Year Programme Happen is a mandatory workshop for all IB-PYP educators. It provides the basic PYP curriculum framework introduction, pedagogies, and the skills to implement the International Baccalaureate programme. Sanjan Nagar is always keen and enthusiastic about meeting modern-day education requirements. For this, it keeps complying with the teacher's professional development.

## IBO–PYP Online Workshops

SNPET always seeks active opportunities for faculty development. Many IB-PYP (Primary Years Program) teachers attended online professional training conducted by IB–PYP trained

professionals. A total of 44 IBO-PYP online workshops have been conducted so far. These trainings were based on four modules covering different topics. This training focused on enriching the teachers and devising well-planned learning

experiences for conducting the prestigious program successfully.

## Inductions Module

All newly hired staff must go through rigorous and well-planned induction modules. The module comprises three significant chunks. Introduction to mission, philosophy and international pedagogies

## IB-PAK –Meetings
