- Discover how AI can be used to optimize student learning and engagement
- Explore strategies to implement in their own classes

## International Baccalaureate Regional Workshops



### MYP Category - I workshop at Dubai

Mr. Saimon Robin Head of the Middle Sanjan Nagar Public Education Trust Higher Secondary school attended **MYP Category -I "Implementing the MYP Curriculum" workshop** being the MYP coordinator of Sanjan Nagar Public Education Trust Higher Secondary School. This workshop was held at Crown Plaza, Dubai for three days, 18th -20th of February 2016.

Asha Joy Paul was workshop leader and the participants were from seven different countries from Asia Pacific region. It was a three days' workshop comprising 10 sessions, as per the agenda points related to the philosophy, authorization process, implementation of Middle years program & assessment system.

The workshop had been very productive in a way that participants cleared certain queries about the MYP programs, requirements, our classroom practices, subjects and implementation.



## Teachers without Frontiers



Teachers without Frontiers (TWF), is a Professional Development program from Idara-e-Taleem-o-Aagahi platform. This teacher'-Initiated Professional Development Program is a capacity building initiative as part of the Teachers without Frontiers (TWF) program.

It had three cycles. Cycle-I was orientation cycle of TWF program for fellows, Cycle –II was Fellow's Training session and The Cycle III was launched for the teachers working in the remote areas and are unfortunately unable to attend teachers' development sessions.

Mr. Saimon Robin, IB-MYP Coordinator and Middle School head became fellows training from Karachi and Bahawalpur during July and August 2015. Mr. Saimon Robin designed training program for 100 teachers and divided it into three phases. The training was held at Sanjan Nagar Pubic Education Trust School. He trained 100 teachers from 17 different schools including 17 male teachers and 73 female teachers in three different phases;

Phase 1: 11th-14th May, 2016

Phase 2: 24th-27th May, 2016

Phase 3: 10th-14 July, 2016

Workshop focus was on Philosophy and Passion of Teaching, Brain & Learning Science, Project Based Learning, ICT and Blended Technology in Education.

## Developing Instructional Leaders through Constructivism 8-9 August, 2016

Sanjan Nagar in collaboration with ASCD Islamabad community organized two days' workshop on “Developing Instructional Leaders through Constructivism” which was mentored by Attiya Anwar. This workshop involved teachers



and heads from Sanjan Nagar and Idara-e- Taleem-o-Aagahi.

The purpose of the workshop was to introduce the idea of constructivism in the classrooms and how teacher collaboration is important for instructional rounds in order to see the teaching practices of a school as a whole. Different sessions were conducted on the topics such as compass point protocol, class room practices inventory, five principles of constructivism, how lectures can be made effective and instructional rounds.

Ms. Beena Raza, our Trustee and Education Committee member attended and sponsored the workshop. Certificates were distributed by Mr. Umair CEO of ASCD connected community.



## Pioneer Research Program

Pioneer Academics is a U.S. based organization founded in cooperation between American university professors and international education experts. The goal of the program is to provide outstanding high school students around the world with challenging and creative research opportunities across a wide range of disciplines. Ms. Itrat Fazal, student of grade 10th got selected as the pioneer student from Pakistan for this Research Program. The Professor assigned to her is Professor Douglas Raybeck. He is professor emeritus of anthropology at Hamilton College selected as the pioneer student from Pakistan for this Research Program.

Students are encouraged to think critically, ask questions and are taught through activities within and outside the class. They are encouraged to ask as many questions as they want and are never discouraged from sharing their ideas and feedback.

Some extracurricular activities in the summer camp include guest lectures, a one day educational trip, and a day where the fellows meet and interact with the students' parents. The camp culminated with a graduation ceremony where students get to take part in an art exhibition, a short play and a Public Speaking opportunity.

## Girl Guide Association Pakistan

In a country like Pakistan where social taboos usually become a hurdle in the way of women, Pakistan Girl Guide Association (PGGA) is earnestly fulfilling its responsibilities while fighting these challenges. The association is the largest voluntary organization for girls and young women in Pakistan and currently has 117,692 members. An interactive book launch using drama is one of the best ways of experiential learning - education through experience acquired outside of the traditional academic classroom setting.


